The Black River Center for Learning is in the Southwest Region near Carlsbad, New Mexico. Directions are as follows:

From Carlsbad: Head South on Highway 180/62; turn left on State Highway 396 at the transmitter tower, go 4 miles.

From El Paso or Van Horn: Take the Carlsbad Highway 180/62 all the way to White's City; Go 5 miles past White City; turn right on State Highway 396 at the transmitter tower & go 4 miles.

From Odessa or Pecos: Follow 285 toward Carlsbad; at Malaga, turn left and go 11.5 miles on State Highway 720.

Be sure to bring appropriate clothing for the March weather, keeping in mind possible participation in outdoor activities like canoeing, horseshoes, basketball, campfire, etc. You will need a sleeping bag or good blanket, sheet, pillow case (a pillow is provided), personal toiletries, towel, wash cloth, soap, Bible, etc.
